OBGyn Referral Preparedness Tool

This template is offered as a tool that can evolve over time as providers build upon existing coordination processes and identify new opportunities for improvement. It is available for use by the Represented Specialty Care Physician and Primary Care Physician for coordination of care referrals and activities. Use of this Referral Preparedness Tool is not required and is optional. It is designed to be a resource and is not a program requirement.

Condition/Event	PCP COORDINATION WITH SPECIALIST
Routine Screening	 Regarding treatment of patients who have mild dysplasia of less than two years in duration refer to ACOG guidelines (Choosing Wisely Measure) Regarding follow-up imaging for clinically inconsequential adnexal cysts refer to ACR guidelines (Choosing Wisely Measure) Regarding the performance of Pap smears on women younger than 21 or those who have had a hysterectomy for non-cancer disease refer to AAFP guidelines (Choosing Wisely Measure)
Maternity Care/Delivery	 Regarding elective, non-medically indicated inductions of labor or Cesarean deliveries before 39 weeks, 0 days gestational age refer to AAFP and ACOG guidelines (Choosing Wisely Measure)
Cervical Cancer	 Regarding the screening of women older than 65 years of age for cervical cancer who have had adequate prior screening and are not otherwise at high risk for cervical cancer refer to AAFP guidelines (Choosing Wisely Measure) Regarding the performance of routine annual cervical cytology screening (Pap tests) in women 30–65 years of age refer to ACOG guidelines (Choosing Wisely Measure) Regarding screening women younger than 30 years of age for cervical cancer with HPV testing, alone or in combination with cytology refer to AAFP guidelines (Choosing Wisely Measure)
Ovarian Cancer	Regarding screening for ovarian cancer in asymptomatic women of average risk refer to ACOG guidelines (Choosing Wisely Measure)
