## **Condition/Event PCP COORDINATION WITH SPECIALIST Routine Screening** 1. Regarding treatment of patients who have mild dysplasia of less than two years in duration refer to ACOG quidelines (Choosing Wisely Measure) (example) **Maternity** 1. Regarding elective, non-medically indicated inductions of labor or Cesarean deliveries before 39 weeks, 0 days Care/Delivery gestational age refer to AAFP and ACOG guidelines (Choosing Wisely Measure) (example) **Cervical Cancer** 1. Regarding the screening of women older than 65 years of age for cervical cancer who have had adequate prior screening and are not otherwise at high risk for cervical cancer refer to AAFP guidelines (Choosing Wisely Measure) (example) **Ovarian Cancer** 1. Regarding screening for ovarian cancer in asymptomatic women of average risk refer to ACOG guidelines (Choosing Wisely Measure) (example)
